FACILITY The Augusta Aquatic Center, 3157 Damascus Road, Augusta GA. (phone 706-261-0424) is an 8-lane, 50 meter pool equipped with non - turbulent racing lanes and Colorado electronic timing. Pool depth at each end is 7 feet and 9 feet in the center of the pool. Seating capacity is 1100, viewed from a mezzanine level. There is a separate 6 lane 25 yard warm-up pool. No seating will be allowed on deck for spectators. **The Augusta Aquatic Center does not allow chairs or coolers in the facility by order of the Fire Marshall.** Ample parking is available behind the building and across the street from the center. There is a drop off lane to unload the swimmers in front of the facility. **The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) . The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming & Georgia Swimming**

ELEGIBILITY Open to all swimmers registered with U.S. Swimming, Inc. Swimmers who **late** enter must show proof of USA registration. Out of state teams must provide proof of USA registration with their entries. There are no time standards for this meet.

FORMAT This is a timed final meet. Meet Management is planning to use Chase Starts. **When using chase starts - all odd numbered heats will start at the North end of the pool and even numbered heats will start at the South end. All 50's and Relays will begin at the South end. All events will be swum fastest to slowest.**

The following events will be deck seeded:
Friday evening events 400m IM and 400m Freestyle
Saturday 400m Freestyle
Sunday 800m Freestyle

Meet management reserves the right to limit the number of heats in any event 400 meters or longer as well as the right to limit overall entries in order to maintain reasonable and allowable timelines.

If excessive entries are received, Meet management also reserves the right to limit the following events: 12 & U 200m IM and 12 & U 200m Free.

ENTRY TIMES All entry times should be in Long Course Meters. Estimated conversions from short course are acceptable. **'NO TIME' Entries WILL NOT be accepted for this meet. Swimmers with NT events should be entered with their estimated times. Any NT entries will be scratched, and those entries will not be refunded.**

Session 2 and 4: Late Entries Open 6:30 Close 8:00
Session 3 and 5: Late Entries and Deck Seeded Open 12:00 Close 1:30

RULES Current USA Rules and Regulations will govern the conduct of the meet unless otherwise noted.

The Meet Referee reserves the right to adjust the warm-up times & start times. **All coaches and officials** must wear current year USA Swimming card at all times while on deck and in hospitality area. **All Officials** must present current certification card at check-in. **All teams** must sign the waiver on the Summary Sheet stating all swimmers and coaches participating in this meet are currently registered with USA Swimming. **Coaches must present upon check-in, a current USA card, and your card must be displayed at all times, to be allowed on deck and in hospitality.** Swimmers are responsible for swimming in their assigned heats and lanes.

The Georgia Scratch Rule (adopted 09/23/06) will be in effect.

ENTRIES A swimmer may enter 5 individual events per day, exclusive of relays. Please submit entries in **HY-TEK TEAM MANAGER format.** Please include printout of each swimmer's entries to be used as a back up. Include first and last name, age, USAS number and seedtime (**NO 'NT' ENTRIES - USE LONG COURSE TIMES**). Also include the signed and dated release form and summary found attached to this announcement. Entries will **ONLY** be accepted on a first come first serve basis. Your entry is not complete until the liability release form and check is received

ENTRY FEES Individual event----- \$4.00 Relays ----- \$6.00
A Georgia travel fund surcharge of \$2.00 will apply to all out of state swimmers. Late entry fees will be double the original entry fees. Checks should accompany the entries and be payable to **Aiken-Augusta Swim League, Inc.**

ENTRY LIMIT The meet will be limited to the first **650** swimmers. If the entries of your team put us over the limit your team's entries will be accepted. The meet director along with the Meet Referee, reserve the right to determine the final number of entries accepted.

ENTRY DEADLINE All entries must be received no later than **Tuesday, April 27, 2010 at 6 PM.** Please waive signature for overnight deliveries. LATE ENTRIES Late entries will be accepted for available lanes that were created from the initial seeding from entries received. Once those lanes are filled no more late entries will be accepted. No additional heats will be created. All late entries will be seeded as NT and the late fee will be double the original entry fee per event and relay. **Late entries must show their USAS registration card to the Clerk of Course** to verify current USAS membership. Late entries will be accepted at Clerk of Course by the following time schedule

13 and older **Medals** 1st - 8th place
Relay Events: 12 & U **Trophies** to 1st place teams: **Medals** to 2nd & 3rd place
Relay Events: 13 and older **Medals** 1st - 3rd place relay teams.

SCORING There is no individual or team scoring for this meet.

**GEORGIA SWIMMING INC.
SCRATCH RULE**

The Scratch Rule used in all meets in Georgia where the meet format has preliminary heats, consolation finals, and finals is the same "Scratch Rule" as that found in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Certain LSC additions listed below apply to all timed final meets as well.

"D. Scratching from finals:

1. Any swimmer qualifying for a C, B, or A (bonus and consolation final or) final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said final shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet. A declared false start or deliberate delay of meet is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.
2. In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition the Referee shall fill the C, B, or A (bonus and consolation final or) final, when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals.
3. Where C and B (bonus and consolation) finals have not been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Referee, the Referee shall re-seed the C, B, or A (bonus final, consolation final or) final, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final.
4. If the C or B (bonus and consolation) final has already been contested, the companion final shall be swum without reseeding for the empty lane(s).

E. Exceptions for failure to compete – No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if:

1. The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
2. A swimmer qualifying for a C, B or A (bonus or consolation final or) final race based upon the results of the preliminaries notifies the Referee within thirty (30) minutes after announcement of the qualifiers for that race that they may not intend to compete and further declares their final intentions within thirty (30) minutes following their last individual preliminary event.
3. It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer."

LSC ADDITIONS:

1. Swimmers that qualify for any additional heats beyond the above mentioned "C, B and A" final races will also be subject to the above rules concerning scratching from finals.

2. In deck seeded events, a swimmer who has checked in, been seeded and fails to compete in said event, shall be barred from his or her next individual event, except as noted in section E above. **This rule also applies in timed finals meets where the meet management has placed limits on the number of heats to be contested or the number of individual entries to be accepted for deck-seeded events, unless otherwise stated in the Meet Information.**

3. There is no scratch rule governing relays and there is no penalty regarding relay scratches.

4. **Qualifiers for all finals heats** and first and second alternates are **those as** identified on the original results of the preliminary heat.

5. The meet official designated to receive initial intentions not to compete and final intentions shall be announced at the beginning of each session. It is suggested that this official be the Clerk of Course.

6. On the final day of LSC Championship competition, any swimmer who has checked in for finals and fails to show will be assessed a \$50 fine. This fine must be paid before the next LSC Championship meet in which the swimmer intends to compete or the swimmer will be barred from competition.

7. "Positive check-in", (for deck seeding), designating a swimmer's intent to swim a race, shall be denoted by the swimmer's or coach's initials next to the swimmer's name on the official entry sheet posted at the Clerk of Course.
